

“Looks Like Our Type”

Discussion Guide

Text: Numbers 11:4-6; 21:4-9

1. Why does God send the serpents? As you read scripture, Moses, David, Jeremiah, Job and others complain to God. What is so different here? See Numbers 11:4-6 for a backdrop.
2. What sort of picture does their complaining paint of God and His character?
3. Is this scene one of judgement; one of grace... or a mixture of the two? Whatever your answer please explain.
4. Note why this event was recorded (I Corinthians 10:6-13)? What then are we to learn?
5. Why do you think God didn't just remove the serpents?
6. As you read John 3:14-15 and realize the “type” pictured (“this” is like “that”), what parallels can you draw between the historical event of Numbers 21 and the historical event of Calvary and it's impact on us?
7. What does God do when you need discipline? When you need relief? How does this compare to God's actions in this passage?
8. What use of this incident does Jesus make (see John 3:14-15; 6:32-40)? What are the two or three main take-aways for you from this lesson?

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
